

Great Ocean Road Cruise; Saturday 13th February 2021

To be in contention for a prize you will need to check-in at three points along the cruise. Each check-in point will be clearly identifiable by the Torquay Rotary Club flags. The first check-in will be manned between 12.30 & 2.00 pm and located at the cruise "starting point", which is at the park on the corner of Strachan and Main Street, Birregurra. The second check-in point, manned between 1.00 & 3.00 pm, will be in Lorne and the final one in Torquay will be manned between 2.30 & 5.00 pm. Winners will be notified as soon as possible following the event, so please make sure you submit the Answer Sheet at the final check-in point, with all details completed.

This is a casual cruise so please drive cautiously, consider the road conditions and other road users. You will be travelling on sealed roads and the answers to all questions are easily visible. Please enjoy your drive and take the time to stop off for refreshments and support local businesses along the way.

Instructions and Questions for Passengers:

- Head south-east on Main Street (C152) continuing on this road all the way to Deans Marsh.
 1. Name the first river you cross after leaving the first check point.
 2. What do the "Hero's" produce?
- Turn right onto Deans Marsh-Lorne Road (C151)
 3. "Salt" isn't just a seasoning; it is also a

 5. What great Park are you driving through?
 6. What % is the steep descent?
- You will soon be entering the built-up outskirts of Lorne (Note:-50 klm/hr) and will probably notice a cemetery up on the right. Be ready to turn right into Howard Street. Sign posted, the Golf Club and Cemetery. *If you miss this turn just do a U-turn at the roundabout ahead.*
- At the end of Howard street you will arrive at the Golf Club carpark. You are now at your second check-in point. There is plenty of space here so take a moment to absorb the views.
- Head back down the hill on Howard Street.
- Turn right back onto Deans Marsh Road and head towards Lorne.
 7. Draw the symbol for the "Tourist Route".
- At the roundabout you can choose to turn right onto the Great Ocean Road and enjoy the township of Lorne OR turn left onto the great Ocean Road and continue on with the cruise.
- Whatever you choose, when you are ready, head North on the Great Ocean Road (B100) towards Torquay. You will remain on the Great Ocean Road for some time now, please enjoy the scenery.

- After entering Torquay continue past the RACV Resort, cross over Spring Creek, then at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Bell Street.
- At the second roundabout, take the 1st exit onto The Esplanade.
- Continue along The Esplanade, turn right into the carpark for "Elephant Walk" which is opposite Zeally Bay Road. This is the same park where the Torquay Car Show is usually held.
- You have arrived at the final check point. Check your details on the first page and hand the completed sheets to one of our Marshals.
